### **Conference "Deep in the Heart of TextESOL"**

*For the first time in TextESOL history, the four TextESOL affiliates successfully hosted a collaborative state conference November 14-15, 2014, in San Marcos. Each affiliate managed a different aspect of the conference, and with virtual meetings, email, and other technological tools, the conference hosts learned new ways to share responsibility, integrate multiple perspectives, and earn one another's trust and respect. Based on the theme, "Deep in the heart of TextESOL," the conference featured over 70 presentations ranging from PK-12, Adult Education, and Higher Education. Keynote speakers included grammar gurus Stacy Hagen and Gretchen Bernabei, state demographer, Dr. Lloyd Potter, and advocacy authority, John Segota from TESOL International. Three pre-conference sessions on November 13, led by leading professional educators, focused on dynamic dialogues revolving around technology, writing, and grammar. Thanks to all those folks from TextESOL V who attended the conference. We loved seeing you there, and we hope you enjoyed your time as you listened, reflected, and learned...deep in the heart.
